Standards of Personal Conduct and Dress (2019)

To participate in the Manti Pageant, we the _____ family, commit to keep the following standards of personal conduct and dress as Representatives of the pageant and the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

We recognize that the purpose of the pageant is to invite the spirit to testify to cast and audience members of the divine mission of Jesus Christ and the restoration of His gospel to the earth through the Prophet Joseph Smith.

Therefore, we commit to live in accordance with the principles of the restored Gospel of Jesus Christ, as taught by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in the "For the Strength of Youth" booklet, throughout your involvement in the pageant.

Specifically, we agree to:

- Abide by the standards of Christian Living taught by the church. We will strive to be gracious, courteous, and considerate of others at all times and observe high principles of honor, integrity, and morality.
- Be honest in all behavior.
- Respect others personal rights, including consideration of others property.
- Keep the word of wisdom. We agreed to abstain from the use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, tea, coffee, and illegal drugs.
- Live the law of Chastity and observe the highest standards of decency.
- Dress modestly and appropriately at all times. We understand that shorts must be at least knee length, and that sleeveless, strapless, tight, or revealing clothing is not appropriate. We further understand that those wearing inappropriate attire will be asked to change.
- Maintain a clean and well-groomed appearance consistent with the guidelines in the "For the Strength of Youth" booklet. We understand that any questions about the appropriateness of personal appearance should be referred to the costume specialists.
- Refrain from profanity, vulgarity and any other inappropriate language.
- Refrain from any behavior that is inconsistent with church standards or would adversely affect the mission, purposes, operations, or image of the pageant or the church.
- Follow all standards and rules established for the pageant cast, including conduct and attendance at all scheduled rehearsals, performances and agree to be actively involved in "cast Missionary" activities

Participant Liability Release Form (2019)

The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (Church) and the Manti Pageant (Pageant). desire to protect the safety, health, and security of all those who visit Church facilities and participate in church or pageant functions. The pageant expects that care and caution will be exercised by all pageant staff, crew, cast, and volunteers to ensure that no one is harmed while fulfilling pageant assignments or participating in pageant activities. This expectation extends to care of church resources and property

We, the undersigned, commit to assist the pageant and in taking every reasonable precaution to prevent accident, injury, or property damage. Further, we execute this release in favor of the pageant and the church, with the intent of binding ourselves, our spouses, if any, and our heirs, legal representatives, and assigns.

In consideration of the pageant, its agents and representatives allowing us to participate in the production and performance of the Manti Pageant, we release and discharge the pageant, its agents and legal representatives, including production staff, crew supervisors, and team leaders, from all claims -- present and future, known or unknown -- in any manner arising out of property damage or personal injury sustained as result of participation.

We understand that participation in pageant activities may involve certain dangers associated with production and performance. We knowingly and voluntarily assume all risks of injury, death or other damage arising out of participation in any pageant activity or use of any pageant property. We commit to use common sense in preserving our own safety and the safety of the group and certify that we are physically able to participate in the pageant and will not be a danger to ourselves or others.

We further understand and agree to abide by the following principles concerning Safety and Security while participating:

- **Have adequate coverage.** Each participant should be covered by personal accident and health insurance. Primary insurance coverage for pageant staff, cast, crew, and volunteers is their own insurance.
- **Be informed.** Every participant has the responsibility to be informed about issues of safety health and security while engaged in pageant activities.
- **Notify of harmful situations.** Every effort should be made to eliminate possible dangers to people or property. Anyone who discovers potentially harmful situation must notify appropriate supervisor immediately.
- **Take responsibility for supervision of dependents.** Parents are responsible for the supervision of their children during all pageant activities and should make arrangements for appropriate watch care when fulfilling other responsibilities.
- **Follow directions and behave responsibly.** No tolerance will be shown for negligent behavior. Or failure to follow safe procedures. Disregarding this mandate may result in termination from further participation
